

# Waterproof pocket for catheter protection

### **Directions for use**

- 1. Cover the catheter lumen(s) with the device.
- 2. Remove the protective sheet from the adhesive.
- **3.** Place the lower margin of the adhesive hole in correspondence to the lower part of the exit-site. Complete the fixing from bottom to top, avoiding wrinkles or airlocks.
- Take shower or bath paying attention not to rub the area near the adhesive.
- **5.** Remove gently from the skin a small strip of adhesive starting from the lower part. Pull carefully with small movements from bottom to top.
